

ORDINANCE NO. 520 AC CMS

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND
OPERATION OF THE CITY INCOME TAX AS AUTHORIZED
BY ORDINANCE NO. 507 AC CMS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring;

SECTION 1. That there be and is herewith appropriated from the
general fund, the amounts as hereinafter set forth, for the purposes of
administering and placing in operation the City Income Tax as authorized
by Ordinance No. 507 AC CMS passed by the City Council, as follows:


- (A) For necessary office furniture, fixtures, and
equipment, the sum of \$1,500.00
- (B) For salaries of necessary personnel to be employed,
the sum of \$2,500.00
- (C) For stationery, printing, office supplies, postage,
advertising, incidentals, et al, the sum of \$3,000.00
- (D) For tax consultant, the sum of \$9,800.00

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
health, and safety; the emergency being the necessity of immediately
providing funds to pay for necessary equipment, supplies, employees,
and personnel, for the collection and administration of the City Income
Tax, and, as such, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
