ACCEPTING THE BID OF BECHSTEIN ASPHALT AND PAVING CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF CHIP AND SEAL PAVING AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY (FOR EAST HAMILTON STREET)
