

ORDINANCE NO. 524 AC CMS

ACCEPTING THE BID OF STANDARD OIL COMPANY  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF FUEL OIL SPECIFICATIONS  
1 & 2 AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The bid of Standard Oil Company for the furnishing of  
fuel oil, Specifications 1 and 2, being the lowest and best bid, the  
same is hereby accepted, said bid being as follows:

SPECIFICATION 1:

Minimum Price - \$ .09603 per gallon  
Maximum Price - \$ .097 per gallon

SPECIFICATION 2:


Minimum Price - \$ .09801 per gallon  
Maximum Price - \$ .099 per gallon


and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for  
the purchase of same.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety,  
and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To  
furnish fuel oil for the Electric Light Plant engines, and shall take  
effect immediately upon passage.
