and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of same.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To furnish fuel oil for the Electric Light Plant engines, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
