

ORDINANCE NO. 525 AC CMS

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENT
OFFICE SPACE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF INCOME
TAX AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has heretofore enacted an Income Tax Ordinance, effective the first of July, 1967, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide office space to house the personnel on record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the offer of Firelands Retirement Center, Inc., to provide the necessary office space at 36 South Pleasant Street, Oberlin, Ohio, on a ground floor location at a rental of \$135.00 per month for six (6) months is hereby accepted.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a lease for said office space.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To aid the City of Oberlin to collect the Income Tax funds and thereby preserving the credit of the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


