EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of McDaniel Construction Company,
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of labor and materials
for Forest Street Water Main Improvement be, and the same is hereby
accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a
contract accordingly, the bid being \$12,440.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, property, and welfare of the City of Oberlin,
State of Ohio, to-wit: To provide improvement to the water facilities
for the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon
passage.


