

ORDINANCE NO 532 AC LMS

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO AMEND SECTION XXVIII OF THE
CHARTER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to consider and devise a method for the enlargement of Allen Memorial Hospital, which is owned in part by the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, by Section XXVIII of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, adopted November 4, 1958, it is necessary to amend the Charter of the City of Oberlin

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring,

SECTION 1. "Section XXVIII Hospital. Now reading as follows.

Any building or buildings and grounds purchased or otherwise acquired by the Municipality for hospital purposes may be leased to a corporation not for profit for a period not to exceed ten (10) years, by an affirmative vote of four (4) members of Council in lieu of the Municipality operating said hospital as prescribed in Section XX of the Charter of the City of Oberlin."

Is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any building of buildings and grounds purchased or otherwise acquired by the Municipality for hospital purposes may be leased to a corporation not for profit for a period not to exceed twenty (20) years, by an affirmative vote of four (4) members of Council in lieu of the Municipality operating said hospital as prescribed in Section XX of the Charter of the City of Oberlin.

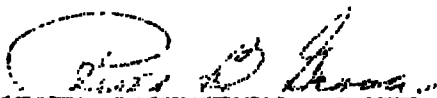
SECTION 2. This proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the Municipality at the general election occurring November 7, 1967, for acceptance or rejection.

SECTION 3. The City Manager shall cause this Ordinance to be certified to the Board of Elections of Lorain County immediately and shall cause the full text of the Ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Municipality once a week for three consecutive weeks during October of 1967 and shall cause a copy of the Ordinance to be mailed to each registered voter of the City of Oberlin at least thirty days before November 7, 1967.

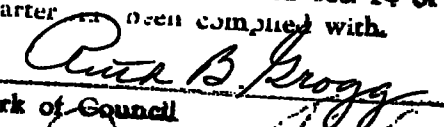
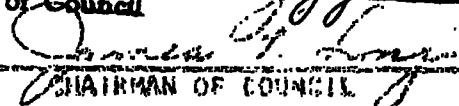
SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite plans for the enlargement of the existing Municipal hospital and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
