

ORDINANCE NO. 538 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BURROUGHS CORP.
FOR THE FURNISHING OF AN ACCOUNTING MACHINE AND
DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7th) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Burroughs Corporation being the best
and lowest bid for the furnishing of an accounting machine and being in
the amount of Seven Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty One and 60/100 Dollars
(\$7,651.60), is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract for same.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite
bookkeeping in the City Office, and shall be in full force and effect from
date of passage.


