

ORDINANCE NO. 543 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF INDEPENDENT
OIL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF GASOLINE, OIL,
ETC., FOR 1968, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Independent Oil Company, being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of Gasoline, Oil, etc., for
the City of Oberlin for 1968, be and the same is hereby accepted and
the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accord-
ingly, the bid being at .083 discount.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emerg-
ency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide necessary service for the motor vehicles of the
City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


