

ORDINANCE NO. 545 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A FIRE PROTECTION
CONTRACT FOR RUSSIA TOWNSHIP AND TO DECLARE
THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the renewal agreement for 1968 between the City of Oberlin and Russia Township, providing that for Fire Protection Russia Township will pay the City of Oberlin the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as a base rate which will include the first five (5) fires during the year. After the first five (5) fires, Russia Township will pay \$75.00 for the first hour of each fire and a rate of \$3.00 per man per hour after the first hour, be and the same is hereby approved.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Oberlin.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for Fire Protection in Russia Township
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


