

ORDINANCE NO. 564 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HEIL COMPANY
FOR THE FURNISHING OF A GARBAGE SANITATION PACKER
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the bid of Heil Company being the best
and lowest bid for the furnishing of a garbage sanitation packer
and being in the amount of Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty
and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,960.00), is hereby accepted and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for same.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preserva-
tion of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the Citizens
of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for sanitary service for the City,
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


