

ORDINANCE NO. 575 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ALLIS CHALMER CO.  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF A SWITCH GEAR & ACCESSORIES  
AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
State of Ohio, five sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Allis Chalmers Company being the lowest  
and best bid for the furnishing of Switch Gear and Accessories, be and  
the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized  
to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$14,200.00, with  
26 weeks delivery.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and  
welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for continuous operation of the Municipal  
Light and Power Plant,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
