Inc., being the lowest and best bid for the construction of an office building for the Municipal Light & Power Plant, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$24,450.00 - \$3,189.00 for Change Orders - \$21,261.00 total.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace. property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:
