

ORDINANCE NO. 576 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CLARK BROS. INC.
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN OFFICE BUILDING FOR THE
MUNICIPAL LIGHT & POWER PLANT AND DECLARE THE SAME
AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio,
five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Clark Bros. Inc., being the lowest and
best bid for the construction of an office building for the Municipal
Light & Power Plant, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the
bid being \$24,450.00 - \$3,189.00 for Change Orders - \$21,261.00 total.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide for necessary office space for the Municipal
Light & Power Plant,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


