

ORDINANCE NO. 578 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GRIFFITH BLACKTOP
INCORPORATED FOR THE EXCAVATING, GRADING AND PAVING
OF WOODLAND AVENUE, OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING THE
SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Griffith Blacktop, Inc., being
the lowest and best bid for the excavating, grading and paving of
Woodland Avenue, Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby authorized
to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being \$27,020.00.


SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

To provide for vehicular traffic,
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


