

ORDINANCE NO. 580 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF BOB BECK CHEVROLET
FOR THE FURNISHING OF A SEWER DEPARTMENT TRUCK AND A
WATER DEPARTMENT TRUCK AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Bob Beck Chevrolet, being the
lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a Sewer Department Truck in
the amount of \$2,487.73 and the furnishing of a Water Department Truck
in the amount of \$2,387.73 be and the same is hereby accepted and the
City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:


To provide for the furnishing of
equipment for the Sewer and Water
Departments of the City of Oberlin

and declaring the same an emergency.


