

ORDINANCE NO. 587 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF K. KESSLER
CO., INC., FOR THE CLEANING & PAINTING OF A
WATER TANK AND DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of K. Kessler Co., Inc., 410 South
Front Street, Fremont, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the
Cleaning and Painting of a Water Tank in the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby
authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being in
the amount of \$3,874.00 for labor, material & equipment to clean &
paint tank; \$3.75 per lineal foot to repair seams; \$ 0.75 each for
repair to rivets; \$ 0.75 each for repair to pits, plus \$150.00 to
paint the tank Mist Blue, 11-A-50, Alumaticolor.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

To preserve City property and
shall take effect immediately upon passage.
