

ORDINANCE NO. 600 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BEECH STREET IN THE
CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, FOR MAINTENANCE AND
DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there has been constructed on a duly dedicated right-of-way in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, a street named Beech Street, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has certified that said street has been improved in accordance with the ordinances and specifications of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Beech Street from its Easterly terminus at Pyle-South Amherst Road Easterly to the Easterly terminus thereof in Clark-wood Subdivision, is hereby accepted for perpetual maintenance by the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To expedite housing in the City of Oberlin, and
shall take effect immediately upon passage.


