## ORDINANCE NO. 601 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ALL SANITARY SEWER LINES. WATER LINES AND STORM SEVERS HERETOFORE EXTENDED WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN BY PRIVATE DEVELOPERS AND AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, over the wears there have been various extensions to the City of Oberlin water lines, storm sewer lines and sanitary sewer lines all under the supervision and according to the specifications of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, Said extensions immediately become the property of the City of Oberlin upon installation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That all previous extensions of the water lines, storm sewer lines and sanitary sewer lines heretofore installed according to the specifications of the City of Oberlin, Ohio and certified as properly installed by the City Engineer of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, are hereby accepted by the City of Oberlin, Ohio,

SECTION 2. That any future installations made after the passage of this ordinance shall be considered accepted by the City of Oberlin. Ohio, upon written statement by the City Engineer of the City of Oberlin, Ohlo, that same have been installed according to the specifications then in force in the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, towit:

"To expedite the development of the City of Oberlin" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
