

ORDINANCE NO. 605 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PAY INCREASES FOR THE
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AMENDING
ORDINANCE No. 558 AC CMS, AND DECLARING THE SAME
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. All full time employees of the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
and/or the Municipal Court of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, are hereby
granted a five per cent (5%) pay increase due to the increased cost of
living, commencing with the pay period beginning October 5, 1968.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-
wit:

To provide for the necessary personnel in all operations
of the City, and

shall take effect immediately upon passage.
