

ORDINANCE NO. 617 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR WATER WORKS  
CHEMICALS AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bids being the lowest and best  
bids for chemical supplies are hereby accepted and the City Manager  
authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bids being as  
follows:

Hydrofluosilic Acid	Harshaw Chemical	10.25 CWT Not delivered


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency


