ORDINANCE NO. 641 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FISHING AREA FOR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin owns two (2) reservoirs South of Morgan Street in the City of Oberlin, which are no longer used for municipal water purposes, and

WHEREAS, certain civic organizations of the City of Oberlin are promoting fishing for minors under the age of Eighteen (18) years who do not need a fishing license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, six (6) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Two (2) City owned reservoirs South of Morgan Street with the main entrance to said reservoirs being Easterly of 205 Morgan Street, are hereby reserved for fishing purposes for the benefit of citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, under the age of eighteen (18) years.

SECTION 2. Said premises may be used by other persons for other recreational activities excluding boating.

SECTION 3. A copy of said Ordinance shall be posted in various conspicuous places around said reservoirs to apprise the public of the intention of Council.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: to provide additional recreational facilities for minors under the age of Eighteen (18) years, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
