

ORDINANCE NO. 645 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CONCRETE
MASONRY CORPORATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
A BRIDGE ON VINE STREET AND TO DECLARE THE
SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5.7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Concrete Masonry Corporation
being the lowest and best bid for the construction of a bridge on
Vine Street, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid
being \$5,296.00, set in place.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

To provide for automotive and pedestrian
traffic,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
