

ORDINANCE NO. 647 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF WHITEY TARRY FORD, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO POLICE CRUISERS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Whitey Tarry Ford, Inc., being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of two police cruisers be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$5,100.00.




