

ORDINANCE NO. 659 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A TAXI CAB FRANCHISE TO
C. MORGAN McDONALD AND DECLARING THE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is presently no taxi cab service in the City of Oberlin,
and

WHEREAS, C. Morgan McDonald has applied for a taxi cab franchise
and has been given the necessary clearances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That C. Morgan McDonald is hereby granted a franchise for
the operation of taxi cab service in the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:


"To provide public transportation within the City
of Oberlin, Ohio,"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
