

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF SALO TREE
SERVICE FOR EMERGENCY TREE SERVICE FOR 1970
AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all
members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following bids of Salo Tree Service
being the lowest and best bids for emergency tree service for
1970 are hereby accepted and the City Manager authorized to
enter into a contract accordingly, the bids being as follows:

Foreman	\$6.00 per hour	Overtime 5 P.M.-8 A.M.
Tree climber	\$5.25 per hour	50% more per mar
Ground man	\$4.75 per hour	
Trucks and all equipment	\$15.00 per hour	
Three man crew trucks and equipment	\$31.00 per hour	\$38.99


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide emergency line and street clearance
within the City of Oberlin and shall take effect
immediately upon passage."
