

ORDINANCE NO. 668 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE SALARY FOR THE
JUDGE OF OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT COMMENCING
JANUARY 1, 1970, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio has the responsibility of fixing compensation of the Judge for the Municipal Court of Oberlin, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected there-
to concurring:

SECTION 1. The salary of the Municipal Judge of Oberlin Municipal Court for the term commencing January 1, 1970, is hereby fixed at \$10,000 per year.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To adjust the pay scale to reflect the rise
in the cost of living

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
