

ORDINANCE NO. 672 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF INDEPENDENT OIL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF GASOLINE, AUTO WASH, OIL AND LUBRICATION AND TO DECLARE THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Independent Oil Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline, auto-wash, oil, and lubrication for 1970 be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being:

Gasoline	.0875 per gallon at Station Discount .0865 per gallon at Bulk Discount
Auto-Wash	1.75
Lubrication	1.50
Oil	4% Discount

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide services and supplies for city-owned equipment, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
