

ORDINANCE NO. 689 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN
PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, AND TO DECLARE THE
SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to acquire sites for sub-
stations for the Oberlin Municipal Power and Light Department, and
whereas a site has been found in Oberlin, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign all
necessary papers to acquire the following described property for a
price of \$6,500.00:

Situated in the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain,
State of Ohio, and bounded and described as follows:

Being on the North side of Lorain Street, 65 feet in
width and extending northerly a depth of 242.10 feet,
and being bounded on the West by property owned by
the Oberlin Improvement and Development Company, and
leased to the Oberlin Printing Company, and bounded
on the East by property owned by the heirs of Joe
Artino.

SECTION 2. There is herewith appropriated the sum of \$6,500.00
from the funds of the Electric Department of the City of Oberlin for
the purchase of this land.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-
wit:


To prepare an immediate site for the sub-
station of the Oberlin Municipal Power and
Light Department in the expansion program,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
