

ORDINANCE NO. 690 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN
PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF RUSSIA AND TO DECLARE
THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to acquire sites for sub-stations for the Oberlin Municipal Power and Light Department, and whereas a suitable site has been found at the corners of Professor Street and Butternut Ridge Road, Russia Township, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign all necessary papers to acquire the following described property for a price of \$5,500.00:

Situated in the Township of Russia, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, and being a part of Original Township Lot 65 in said Township, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the easterly line of Professor Street and southerly line of Butternut Ridge Road; thence easterly in said southerly Butternut Ridge Road line, 200.0 feet to a point; thence southerly parallel to Professor Street, 189.12 feet to a point and northerly line of lands conveyed to Thomas and Willie May Terry by deed dated November 21, 1968 and recorded in Deed Volume 936, Page 787 of Lorain County Record of Deeds; thence in said northerly line, parallel to Butternut Ridge Road; westerly a distance of 200.0 feet; to the easterly line of Professor Street; thence in said easterly Street Line, northerly 189.12 feet to the place of beginning of lands herein described; containing within said bounds 0.8683 acres of land.

SECTION 2. There is herewith appropriated the sum of \$5,500.00 from the funds of the Electric Department of the City of Oberlin for the purchase of this land.




To prepare an immediate site for the sub-station of the Oberlin Municipal Power and Light Department in the expansion program,
