

ORDINANCE NO. 693 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF
PUBLIC DEFENDER WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN
AND PROVIDING COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. There is herewith established the part-time position of Public Defender for the City of Oberlin who shall give legal assistance, free of charge, to all eligible citizens of Oberlin, Eighteen (18) years of age or older who are charged with misdemeanors other than traffic or motor vehicle offenses by the Oberlin City Police Department or a private citizen.

SECTION 2. Any citizen of the City of Oberlin, Eighteen (18) years of age or older who states that he is unable to pay for a lawyer shall be eligible to receive the legal assistance of the Public Defender if otherwise qualified under Section One above.


SECTION 3. The salary of Three Thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$3,000) per year payable in bi-weekly installments is herewith established for this position.

SECTION 4. Appointment of the Public Defender shall be by the City Council for an indefinite time.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
