

ORDINANCE NO. 695 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF FIFE ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF TWO (2) 1500 KVA TRANSFORMERS AND ONE (1) DOUBLE ENDED SUBSTATION AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Fife Electric Company being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of two (2) 1500 KVA Transformers and one (1) Double Ended Substation, be and the same is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, the bid being \$39,740.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide equipment for the substation necessary for the enlargement of the Oberlin Municipal Light System",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
