

ORDINANCE NO. 697 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL AGE LIMITATIONS FOR THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT OF FIREMEN IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has heretofore prescribed the age limits for original appointment of Firemen as prescribed in the Ohio Revised Code under the Civil Service Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has now amended such Statutes to provide for a larger range in the age limits in the appointment of Firemen on original appointments, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin deems it necessary for the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to prescribe a method under said State Statute enlarging the age limits for original appointment of Firemen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Any person who is between the age of Twenty-One (21) and Thirty-Six (36) years of age, not having reached his 36th birthday and having reached his 21st birthday, is eligible for original appointment to the Oberlin Fire Department as a Fireman, provided he passes all the necessary Civil Service examinations and physical examinations.

SECTION 2. Any person who is between the age of Eighteen (18) and Twenty-One (21) years of age is eligible for appointment as a Cadet Fireman appointment to the Fire Department of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, upon completion of the necessary physical examination and necessary Civil Service examination.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit;


To secure Fireman
