## ORDINANCE NO. 698 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF A LEASE OF HOSPITAL BUILDINGS, LANDS, FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT AND EXECUTION OF THE RENEWAL LEASE BY THE CITY MANAGER AND CLERK OF COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has heretofore entered into a lease of hospital buildings, lands, facilities and equipment as described in the form of lease attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that said lease should be renewed at this time for an additional term of one year in order to provide necessary medical facilities for the City and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorein County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager and the Clerk of Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Oberlin, a lease substantially in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof to renew an existing lease of hospital buildings, lands, facilities and equipment from the City of Oberlin and the Joint Township Hospital Board of Camden, Pittsfield and Russia Townships, Lessors, to Allen Memorial Hospital, Lessee, which existing lease will expire on July 1, 1970.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that the renewal of the lease provided for herein is required in order to provide necessary medical facilities which are urgently needed for the City and its residents; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately upon its passage by Council.
