

ORDINANCE NO. 700 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF STANDARD OIL
COMPANY FOR FUEL OIL AND DECLARING THE SAME AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain
County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

Spec. 2	.1118 per gal.	1% dis.	10 days


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
