- (a) Maintain the improvement in accordance with the provisions of the statutes relating thereto and make ample financial and other provisions for such maintenance; and
- (b) Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions in a manner satisfactory to the State of Ohio and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes and permit no signs, posters, billboards, roadside stands or other private installations within the right-of-way limits; and
- (c) Regulate parking in the following manner:

No parking permitted.

SECTION V (Traffic Control Signals and Devices)

That traffic control signals will not be installed on the project without prior approval by the State and the City Williams will place and maintain all traffic control devices conforming to the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices on the improvement in compliance with the provisions of Section 4511.11 and related sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI (Right-of-Way, Utility Rearrangement and Saving the State of Ohio Harmless of Damages)

- (a) That all existing street and public way right-of-way within the City/XXXXXXX which is necessary for the aforesaid improvement, shall be made available therefor.
- (b) That thex \$ coxex/Municipality will acquire any additional right-of-way required for the construction of the aforesaid improvement.
- (c) That arrangements have been or will be made with and agreements obtained from all public utility companies whose lines or structures will be affected by the said improvement and said companies have agreed to make any and all necessary plant removals or rearrangements in such a manner as to be clear of any construction called for by the plans of said improvement and said companies have agreed to make such necessary rearrangements immediately after notification by said CityXXXXxxxx or the Department of Highways.
- (e) That the construction, reconstruction, and/or rearrangement of both publicly and privately owned utilities, referred to in subsections (c) and (d) above, shall be done in such a manner as not to interfere unduly with the operation of the contractor constructing the improvement and all backfilling of trenches made necessary by such utility rearrangements shall be performed in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Department of Highway Construction and Material Specifications and shall be subject to approval by the State.
- (f) That the installation of all utility facilities on the right of way shall conform with the requirements of the Bureau of Public Roads Policy and Procedure Memorandum 30-4 "Utility Relocations and Adjustments"
- (g) That said City/XXXXXXX hereby agrees that the said Department of Highways of the State of Ohio, shall be and is hereby saved harmless from any and all damages or claims thereof arising from or growing out of the certification or obligations made or agreed to in Sections (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) hereinabove.

SECTION VII (Emergency Clause)

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting highway improvements to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
