

ORDINANCE NO. 718 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR SUBSTATION EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Westinghouse ^{lowest and} Electric Company for substation equipment being the ~~best~~ bid, same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being the sum of Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$13,170.00).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the Public Peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit: To expedite the construction of loop line and sub-stations for the electric plant in order to expedite flow of electricity to the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
