

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HIBBARD & FRANKLIN FOR THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF A 12" WATER MAIN SOUTH TO LORAIN COUNTY JOINT VOCATIONAL SCHOOL, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Hibbard & Franklin being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing and installation of a 12" Water Main South to Lorain County Joint Vocational School be and the same is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract accordingly when the Lorain County Joint Vocational School District has deposited the total contract price with the City of Oberlin, the bid being \$28,595.00 with 90 days completion.


SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To insure an adequate water supply to citizens attending the Lorain County Joint Vocational School, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
