

ORDINANCE NO. 741 AC CNS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING BIDS FOR WATERWORKS  
CHEMICALS AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,  
State of Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:
