

ORDINANCE NO. 762 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JULIAN W. PERKINS, INC., OF ELYRIA, OHIO, FOR PETROLEUM HANDLING EQUIPMENT FOR A CITY EQUIPMENT STATION, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Julian W. Perkins, Inc., of Elyria, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a steel tank, pump and meter and other allied equipment for a City equipment station, be and the same is hereby accepted, said bid being \$2,641.00, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign a Contract accordingly.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide certain petroleum handling equipment necessary for use by the City Equipment Station, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
