ORDINANCE NO. 764 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 511.03 PARAGRAPHS (b) AND (c) AND DECLARING THE SAME EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of Codified Ordinance 511.03 are hereby amended to read as follows:

- "(b) Such notice shall provide for appearance at the City Hall or any other place which may be designated for the purpose by the City Manager. If appearance is made within five days, the Owner, keeper or harborer shall be fined Eight Dollars (\$8.00) for the violation.
- (c) If appearance is not made within the prescribed five days, then a Warrant for the arrest of the owner, keeper or harborer shall be issued by the Police Department. Upon conviction, the penalty shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) and costs for the first offense, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and costs for the second offense, and Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs for each subsequent offense."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To protect the citizens of the City of Oberlin by adjusting the penalty charged for allowing dogs to run at large in the City of Oberlin, Ohio,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
