AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 507 AC CMS.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 13 - Allocation of Funds, of Ordinance No. 507 AC CMS, now reading as follows:

"The funds collected under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deposited in the Income Tax fund and said fund shall be distributed and used for the following purposes, to-wit:

- 1. Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all cost of collecting the taxes and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
- 2. A minimum of 1/2 of balance for Capital Improvements.
- 3. General Fund-Balance of Funds after the above expenditures."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 13. Allocation of Funds.

The funds collected under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deposited in the Income Tax Fund and said fund shall be distributed and used for the following purposes, to-wit:

- 1. Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all cost of collecting the taxes and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof.
- 2. General Fund-Balance of Funds after the above expenditures.
