

ORDINANCE NO. 780 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GOOD ROADS MACHINERY CORP. FOR FURNISHING OF A CATCH BASIN CLEANING MACHINE FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, Five-Sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of Good Roads Machinery Corp. being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of a catch basin cleaning machine be and the same is hereby accepted, said bid being \$8,600.00, net.


