AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GENERAL ELECTRIC SUPPLY CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE VOLTAGE REGULATORS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

"To provide mechanical equipment for the Oberlin Municipal Light & Power System and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
