

ORDINANCE NO. 783 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GENERAL ELECTRIC
SUPPLY CO. FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE VOLTAGE
REGULATORS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND
DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected
thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the bid of General Electric Supply Co.,
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of three voltage
regulators be and the same is hereby accepted, said bid being for
\$2,220.00 with delivery in eight (8) weeks for each regulator,
making a total bid of \$6,660.00.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an
emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of
Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide mechanical equipment for the Oberlin
Municipal Light & Power System and shall take
effect immediately upon passage."
