

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GULF OIL CORP. FOR SPECIFICATION NO. 1 AND THE BID OF STANDARD OIL COMPANY FOR SPECIFICATION NO. 2 FOR FUEL OIL FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL LIGHT & POWER SYSTEM, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, Five-Sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Gulf Oil Corporation for Specification No. 1 of fuel oil used in the operation of the Power Plant, be and the same is hereby accepted, said bid being \$.1110 per gallon, and that the bid of Standard Oil Company for Specification No. 2 of fuel oil used in the operation of the Power Plant, be and the same is hereby accepted, said bid being their alternate bid for \$.1165 per gallon with a discount of 1% - 10 Days.

SECTION 2. The Acting City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with Gulf Oil Corporation and Standard Oil Company accordingly.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide fuel for the operation of the Oberlin Municipal Light & Power plant, and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
