

ORDINANCE NO. 821 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS
FOR SALARIES FOR THE RECREATION COMMISSION
FOR THE YEAR 1971 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Recreation Commission has an anticipated deficit of \$4,100.00 for the balance of 1971,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. There is herewith appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, an additional amount of \$1,952.00 to the Recreation Commission for the year 1971.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To provide salaries for the Recreation
Commission with necessary funds for the
balance of 1971

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
