

ORDINANCE NO. 832 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SNOWMOBILES IN  
CERTAIN PARTS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN.

DATED: December 28 , 1971

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of  
Oberlin, the majority of all members elected thereto  
concurring:

SECTION 1: Definitions.

A snowmobile is herewith defined as a vehicle  
on a sled or tracks, propelled by an internal combustion  
engine or some other power device other than physical,  
capable of being operated on the surface of the ground,  
highways or other open places. It shall be further defined  
as in any legislation enacted in the future by the State  
Legislature pertaining to snowmobiles.

SECTION 2: From and after the passage of this  
Ordinance the operation of a snowmobile on any of the streets  
of the City of Oberlin shall be prohibited unless said  
snowmobile is properly registered and licensed with the  
State of Ohio.

SECTION 3: From and after the effective date of  
this Ordinance it shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile  
on any property owned or under the control of the City of  
Oberlin, or upon the school property of the Oberlin Public  
Schools.

SECTION 4: Upon violation of either Section 2  
or 3 above, upon finding of guilty, the violator shall be  
fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00 and costs  
of prosecution.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force  
and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by  
law.
