

ORDINANCE NO. 836 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BIDS FOR GASOLINE
FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR 1972 AND DECLARING
SAME AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, Five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Standard Oil Company of Ohio,
being the lowest and best bid for the furnishing of gasoline for
use by the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and the same is hereby
accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter
into a contract accordingly, the bids being as follows:

Gasoline, Regular ----	0.1260 per gallon
Gasoline, Premium ----	0.1460 per gallon

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City
of Oberlin, Ohio, towit:

"To provide fuel for the motor vehicles of the City
of Oberlin, Ohio and shall take effect immediately
upon passage."
