

ORDINANCE NO. 848 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF  
THE OBERLIN IMPROVEMENT AND DEVELOP-  
MENT COMPANY

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Improvement and Develop-  
ment Company has offered to donate to the City of Oberlin  
8.18 acres Northerly from Artino Street, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is interested in  
industrial development and the promotion of industry  
within the City of Oberlin in order to help the economic  
base of the citizens of the City of Oberlin,

NOW, therefore, be it ordained by the Council  
of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all  
members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the offer of the Oberlin Imp-  
rovement and Development Company for approximately 8.18  
acres of land be, and the same is hereby accepted, to-  
gether with the option to purchase certain land on the  
Easterly side of Artino Street extended along said strip  
of land.

SECTION 2. The City Manager of the City of  
Oberlin is hereby authorized to execute an acceptance of  
the offer of the Oberlin Improvment and Development Co.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared  
to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate  
preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of  
the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To improve streets in the City of Oberlin and  
shall take effect immediately upon passage."
